### FRIZINGHALL, BRADFORD, UNITED REFORMED CHURCH. REDUNDANT PIPE ORGAN.

The church closed on October 2008 and the pipe organ is available for disposal. The organ is a 2 manual and pedal instrument built by W. Andrews of Bradford (one time employee of J.J. Binns) in about 1890. The organ was last overhauled and the action renewed in 1986. It has subsequently been maintained by Michael Fletcher of Shelf, Halifax. It is not currently playable because of a fault in the blower. It was last tuned in 2006 and appears to be in good condition.
